

What is a “List of Accomplishments”?

A List of Accomplishments is a **brief summary** of your achievements, leadership experiences, service activities, awards, school involvement, sports, clubs, religious activities, work experience, and other accomplishments that have helped shape you as a Scout and young adult. The Eagle Board of Review uses this information to learn more about you beyond your Eagle Scout application.

Keep it concise (1–2 pages), organized by category, and include activities from Scouting, school, community, and personal interests.
